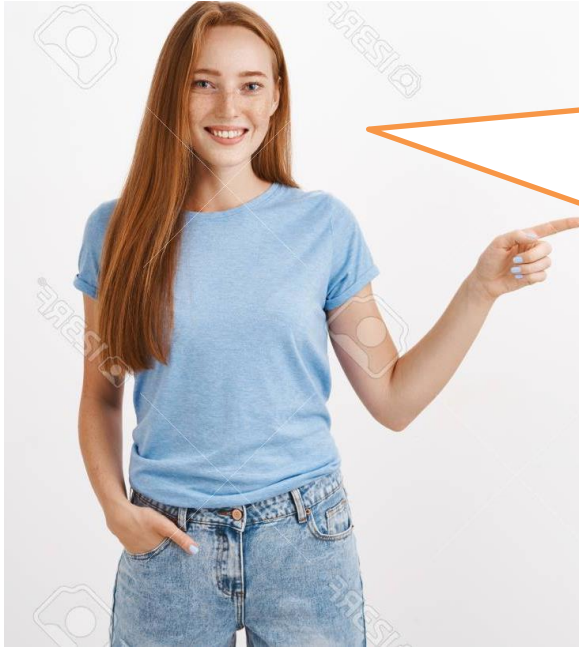


A man tried to rob the bank.
